TOP TEN THINGS every parent should know...

- 1.) All Camps (Leadership, Percussion, Color Guard, Rookie and Full Band) will be held at Etowah High School. Please look for e-Notices to provide the exact location information you will need.

	July 22	Exhibition & End of Band Camp Social - All band members and parents are invited! (7:00 pm)

- 2.) Hydration/food consumption Tips:

- Eat a good breakfast & lunch but limit milk consumption.
- Bring a large, insulated jug of ice water/Gatorade.
- No soda! Water and ice refills will be provided.
- Bring your dinner; you cannot leave the campus.
- Drink lots of water and/or Gatorade.

- 4.) Cool Clothing Tips:

- Wear shorts and a light-colored cotton top (basic school dress code applies).
- Wear socks and low-top tennis shoes (no sandals).
- Wear a hat and sunglasses.
- Wear and bring lots of sunscreen.
- Bring a towel to soak in cool water, if you wish.

- 5.) Wind and Percussion Instruments:

- Wind and Percussion need instruments with accessories.
- Wind and Percussion need flip folder with lyre to hold music. (Flip folders and lyres can be obtained at any local music store for a few dollars.)

- 6.) Do not take salt tablets, since they do not replace water loss and can adversely affect your health.

How to Navigate in your Charms Account

Your Charms account contains all of your students information (class, address, phone, email, etc.) as well as the parents information. Charms is used to communicate with you via email so it is very important to make sure that all email address are entered correctly. At the beginning of the school year, you will be emailed information on what your student password is to access your Charms account.

To access Charms go to the Band website, www.ehseagleband.org. On the left hand side of the page, you will see a blue menu box. Under that box is a link to connect to Charms. Click on this link. Type in your student password that you received in the box marked student password. On this page you will see several different icons. Click on the icon at the bottom that says personal info & make sure that all of this information is correct. Correct anything that needs to be corrected & then click on update. Any news items that have been emailed out can also be viewed at the bottom of the main page. If you click on the icon labeled finances, you will see all information regarding any money you have paid, fundraisers you have participated in & fees that have been applied in this section. Should you have any questions on the finances, please contact Carol King, our treasurer at cking_3599@yahoo.com. Any handouts can be viewed by clicking on the word handouts in the bar at the top of the page. The band calendar can be viewed by clicking on the word calendar in the bar at the top of the main page as well as on the main Band website.

It is very important that anytime you change a phone number, email address or such, that you go into your students account & change this information. We send all communications via our email system & our calendar, so please keep your information current & check the calendar often.
